## Healthy Kids

### Articulation

Articulation is the process by which sounds, syllables and words are formed when your tongue, jaw, teeth, lips and palate work together to make speech. Following are some suggestions to assist your child's sound development:

- ✳ Be a good speech model for your child. Pronounce words clearly and slowly for your child to hear and imitate.
- ✳ Let your child watch your face, lips and tongue as you form sounds and words, prolonging the speech sounds your child has difficulty saying; eg. "Where is your sssock?"
- ✳ Make a scrapbook; cut out and paste pictures of words your child is having difficulty saying and practice them.
- ✳ Model correct pronunciation at natural times during the day. Don't always correct your child. Eg. If your child says "I got a pish", you could say, "Yes, you have a fish", emphasizing the target sound slightly.
- ✳ Play sound games with your child; this will increase their overall awareness and discrimination of sounds. Eg. Play with magnetic letters, read rhyming books, say nursery rhymes, or sing songs slowly.

## OUTSTANDING STUDENT MEDALS

As part of Franklin's welfare system a student may become an OUTSTANDING STUDENT. To do this a student needs to have received:

- ☐ Four (4) Super Student certificates in either 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and finishing in 2012);
- ☐ Present the 4 certificates to your **class teacher** by Friday 23 November to receive **an OUTSTANDING STUDENT MEDAL** on Presentation Evening;
- ☐ NB students in K, Yr 1 and Yr 2 are ineligible to receive an Outstanding Student Medal as they will have received insufficient certificates;
- ☐ Only one Outstanding Student Medal is presented to a student during their primary education.
