CHOIR IN ACTION

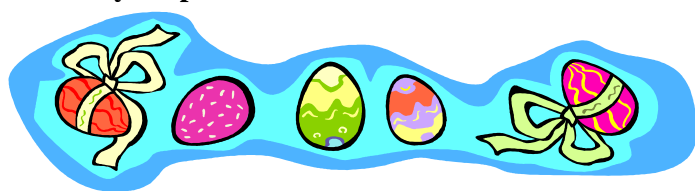
Franklin's Primary choir hit the right notes and thoroughly entertained Tumut's senior citizens at the RSL Club last Wednesday.

PBL Corner – What are PBL Tokens?

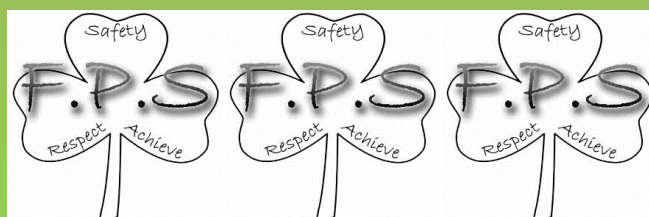
Positive Behaviour for Learning
