## Healthy Kids

### A Community Health initiative Drug Action Week 17-23 June

Alcohol consumption amongst children as young as 12 is a growing concern in our community. One in five teens are drinking more than 10 standard drinks at a time, an amount considered high risk even for adults.

Discussions about alcohol should begin before children reach the age of 10-11 years. Children are never too young to start talking about the effects of alcohol and need to know what their parents think about drinking. While they are not the only influence in teenagers' lives, parents are role models for their children and are an important influence on young people's decisions. Parents should think about their own drinking practices in the presence of their children.

For a range of reasons some parents allow their children to have small amounts of alcohol and others do not. Nevertheless it is important to remember that the legal age for drinking alcohol is 18 because it causes long term physical damage in young people, particularly to the developing brain, stomach and liver. Secondly there are very real negative consequences of violence, sex and physical harm associated with drinking alcohol. The number of young people injured or killed in alcohol-related road accidents is also a major concern.

**There is no safe level of alcohol use for teenagers, especially those under the age of 18.**
