*Semester 1 student reports will be sent home with students on Friday 22 June. Parent teacher interviews are scheduled for the following week.*

The student report provides a summary of your child's **academic achievements** in the Key Learning Areas (subjects taught) as well as an indication of **effort** towards work and school life. It is a carefully prepared assessment of your child's progress, based on a program of formal and informal testing, ongoing evaluation and observation.

I encourage parents to be positive in reading the report complimenting your child in areas of strength. Similarly, encouragement is needed where the report indicates that more time is needed for your child to develop a particular skill. It is important to remember that children of similar age differ in social, academic, emotional and physical development and thus have varying learning styles.

## PARENT - TEACHER INTERVIEWS

A written report is unable to convey all the information a teacher wishes to say about your child. For this reason **Parent -Teacher interviews** will be offered by all class teachers from **Monday 25 to Friday 29 June**. Included with today's newsletter is a schedule of interview times. I would encourage all parents to take up this offer
