It will be a mufti day with students encouraged to dress in the colours of the Aboriginal flag –

-  represents Aboriginal people, past, present & future.
-  represents yellow ochre and the Sun, giver of life.
-  represents the red earth, Aboriginal spiritual relationship to the land and red ochre used in ceremonies

Aboriginal parents and grandparents are invited to be part of the NAIDOC celebrations from 12:30 to see student achievement and share lunch with the children/grandchildren.

Healthy Hearts: Family breakfast ideas

- ♥ Stock the fridge with low-fat milk and reduced-fat yoghurt.
- ♥ Place margarine – not butter – on the table for toast. On the weekends, cook up mushrooms, scrambled eggs, tomatoes and baked beans and melt low-fat cheese on top.
