EARN and LEARN



FOOD for LEARNING - BREAKFAST

It's the most important meal of the day - but one in four children will skip breakfast.

At school, a hungry child can lose concentration in class and have no energy for playtime. Snacking on unhealthy foods, such as chips or biscuits can make matters worse.

A healthy breakfast could include cereal (e.g. Weet-Bix, rolled oats), fruit, scrambled eggs or baked beans on toast.



Avoid cereals high in saturated fat and added sugars. Healthier cereals have the National Heart Foundation Approved logo on the packet.


