POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR for LEARNING (PBL)

Changes at Franklin

- The morning assembly bell at 9:05am and not 9:10am;
- Students sit in class groups to eat recess and lunch.
- Misbehaviour in the classroom and playground will result in the student being placed on reflection (replaces detention).
- Students who break a school value (respect, safety and achievement) are placed on reflection within 24 hours;
- Reflection lasts for 1 day.
- Continued placement on reflection will result in the student being placed on in-school suspension and may result in suspension from school.
- PBL signage will be erected across the school and will detail expectations in a range of settings.
- PBL awards will be presented at school assemblies.
