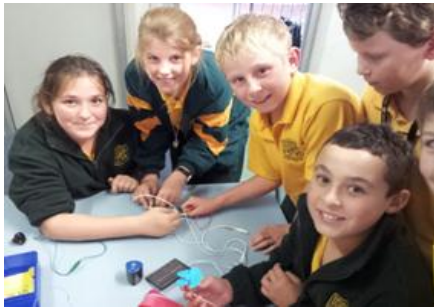

5/6 in Action

In COGs this term, 5/6G are studying 'Physical Phenomena'. As a part of this unit we have been looking at the different types of energy, including electricity. During class, students have been constructing circuits and manipulating them to experiment with the effect that conductors and insulators have on the circuits.



Emma, Talia, Ethan and Shay experimented with the effect of adding more batteries into circuits. The more batteries they added, the faster the fan turned.
