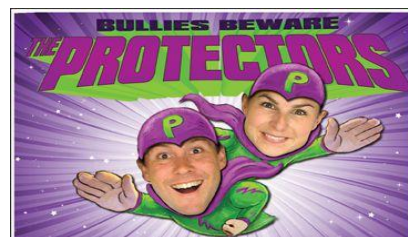


Bullies Beware THE PROTECTORS are coming.....

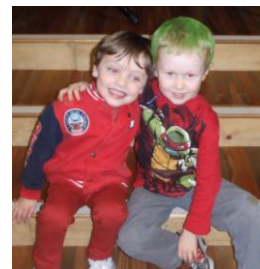

PBL Corner - What exactly is PBL?

PBL (Positive Behaviour for Learning) is a process for creating safer and more effective schools. PBL includes school-wide procedures and processes intended for:

- ALL students, ALL staff and in ALL settings
- Non-classroom settings within the school environment.
- Individual classrooms and teachers.
- Individual student support for the estimated 3-7% of students who present the most challenging behaviours.

PBL **IS NOT** a program or a curriculum.

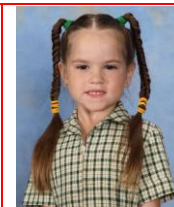
