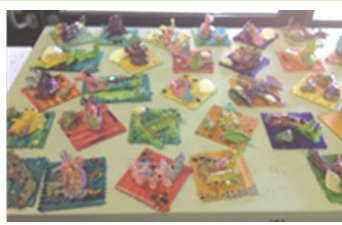
Week 5 Term 3

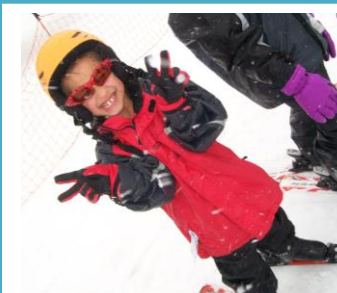

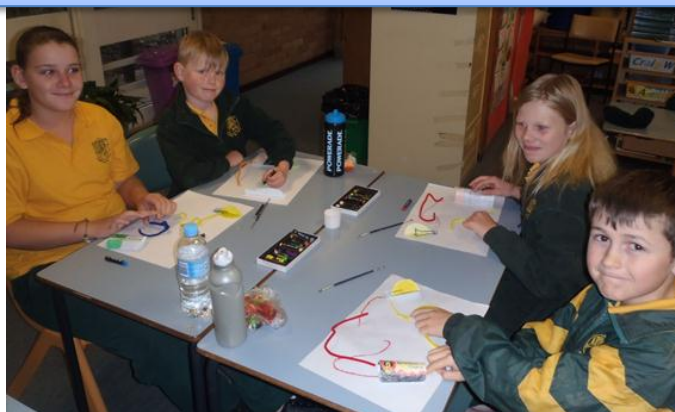
