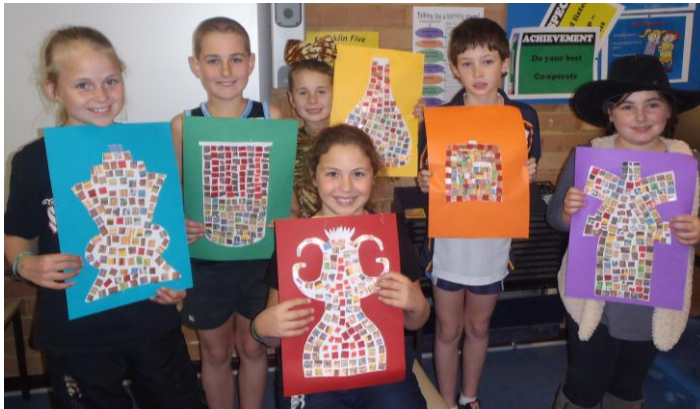

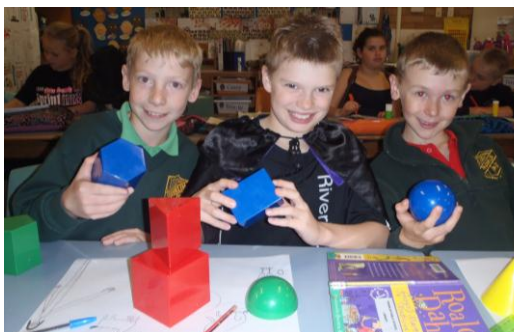

NEW WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

We have many volunteers working at Franklin School. In order to ensure safety standards are met, we will soon be required to have all volunteers gain a WWCC. This involves going on line and completing a application form. Once submitted a WWCC application number will be issued to you. You are then required to take this to the RTA with a 100 points for ID. Upon completing the forms you will then receive a letter that the school office requires to file which gives you clearance to help in the school setting. **This Wednesday we will go through the process at the P&C meeting.**
