### LUNCH BOX- 'Key to an Alert Mind'

When packing your child's lunch box parents need to provide a range of nutritious foods. Include:

- ✓ a sandwich or bread roll.
- ✓ a piece of fruit.
- ✓ a range of snacks.
- ✓ Processed snacks are **extras** and **not lunch** and should be limited to no more than 2 items.
- ✓ For younger students
- ✓ cut food into manageable pieces;
- ✓ cut or partly open pre-packaged snacks as little fingers find it difficult to open them.
- ✓ Talk to your child about what they like to eat at school.
- ✓ If food is continually coming home you have packed too much or your child does not like the food provided.
- ✓ Develop a '**sandwich**' habit from Kindergarten.
- ✓ Don't allow your child to eat only junk food.
- ✓ Keep an eye on the amount of money your child brings to school. Students may give money to friends.
- ✓ **Remind your child not to share his/ her food.**
