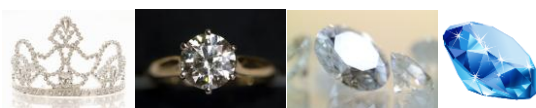
Have a restful and enjoyable holiday everyone. Term 2 commences for students on **Tuesday 29 April**.

Nutrition Snippet

## The simplest way

to work out what 2 fruit & 5 veg looks like.

Eating 2 serves of fruit and 5 serves of vegetables every day will help keep you and your children healthy. But what does a serve look like?

A serve of fruit is 150 grams or:

1 medium fruit (e.g. apple) or  
2 small fruit (e.g. apricots)  
or 1 cup of chopped or canned fruit

A serve of veg is 75 grams or:

½ cup of cooked veg or  
½ medium potato or  
1 cup of salad

So as an adult, eating just 2½ cups of cooked vegetables will give you your daily recommended intake. Try spreading it across different meals to make it easier to reach your daily target.

Our COGS unit this term is called, "OUR FAMILIES".

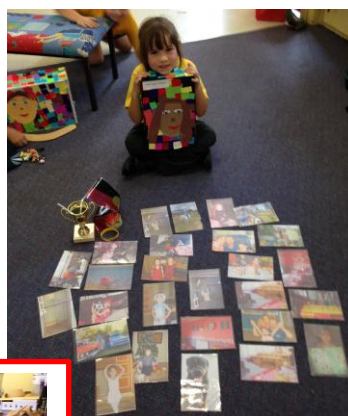
2M have been presenting their personal artefacts to the class.
