Time: Be at school at 7am. The bus leaves promptly at 7:15am and returns at 3:45pm.

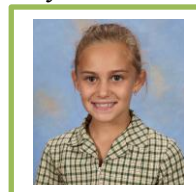

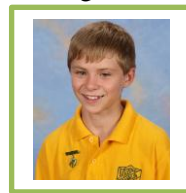
MORTIMER SHIELD

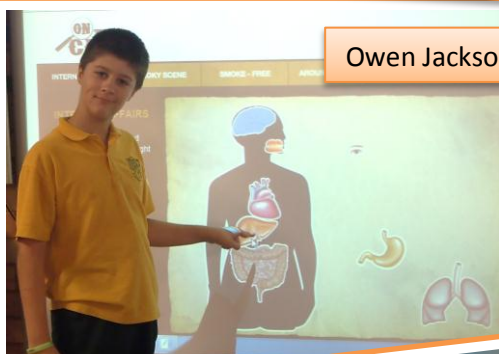
