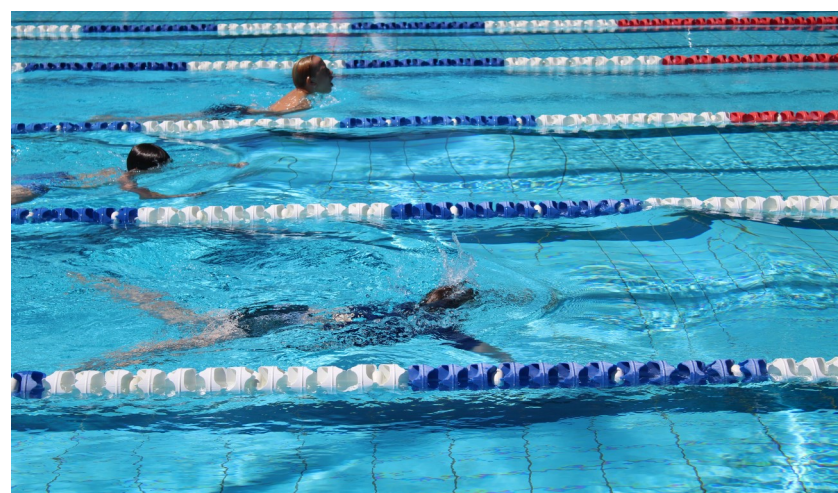


Swimming School starts on Monday 2nd December, 2019.

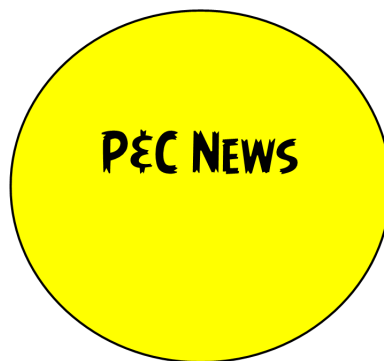

Please make sure your child has their musical instrument at school on Wednesdays.

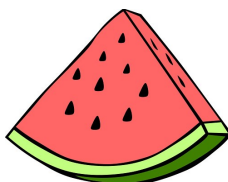
SCHOOLS as COMMUNITY CENTRE

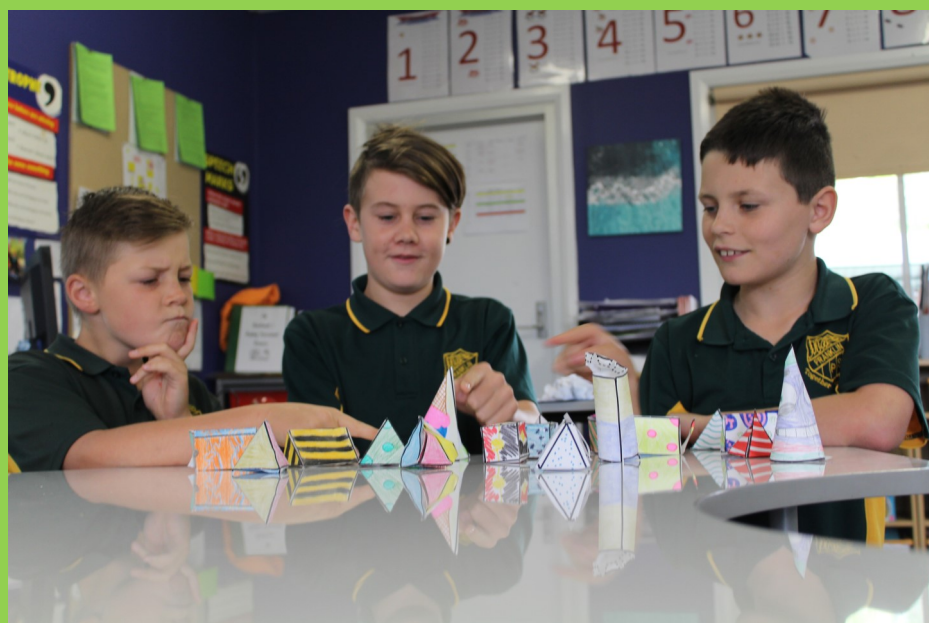


Chisholm in Action

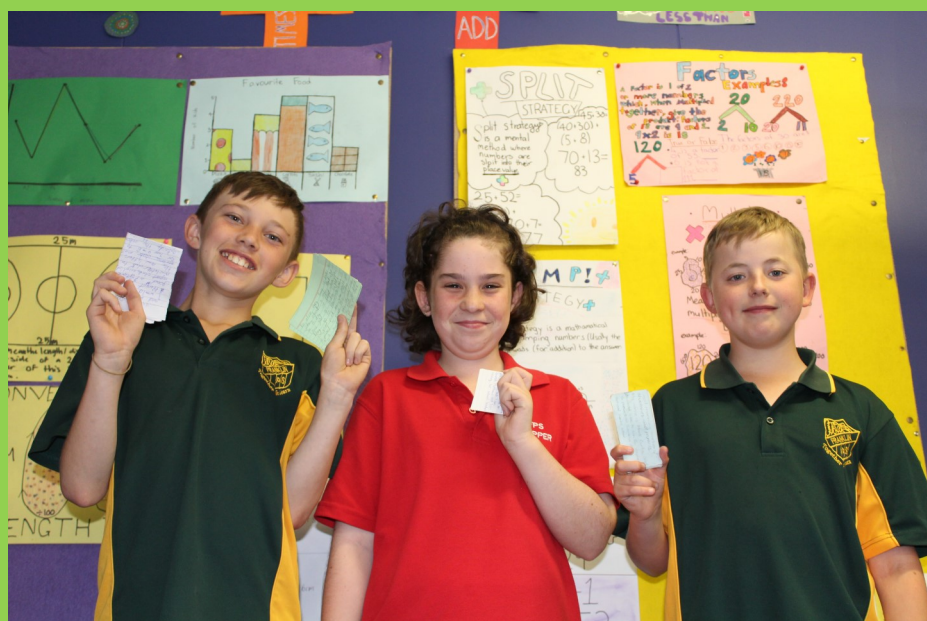
The children of Chisholm have been studying poetry and the tools that they can use to be an effective poet.
