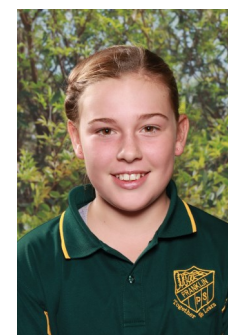

Swim School has been awesome over the past 2 weeks and we loved having the opportunity to exercise at the pool.

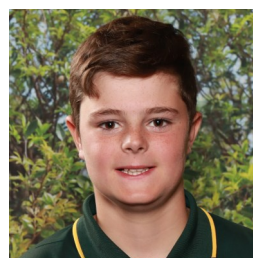

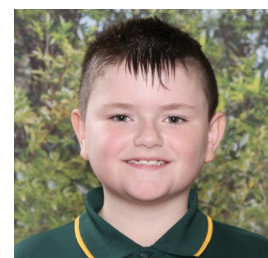
