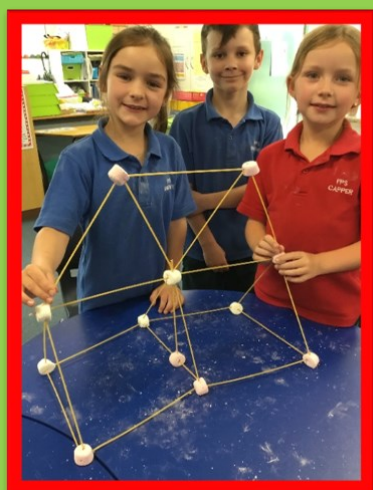

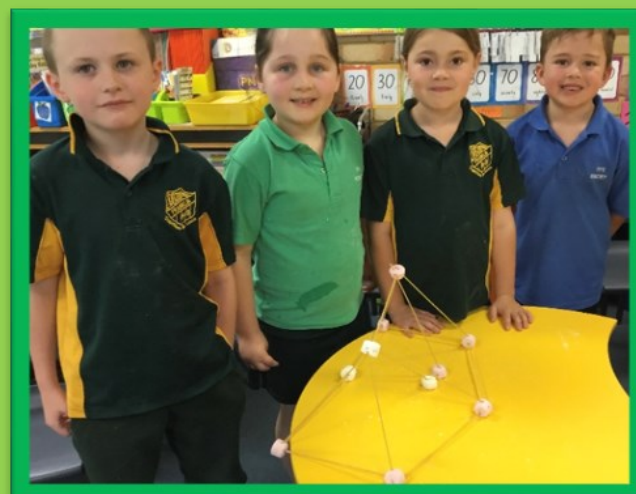

Bass in Action

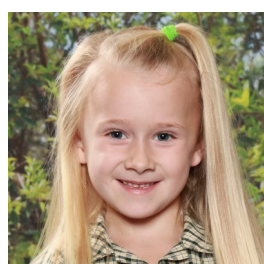
The students in Bass had fun in science investigating the differences in materials when they undergo change. They were challenged to make the tallest tower using uncooked spaghetti and marshmallows.

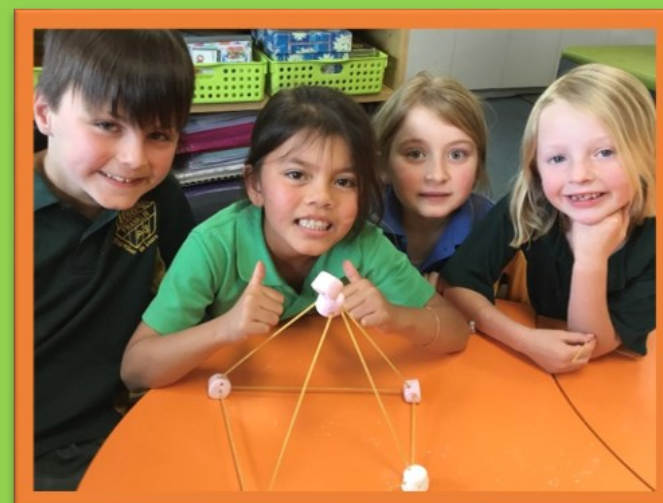
