During Art, Sturt made eagle headbands and our Aboriginal song verse was about Eagles.



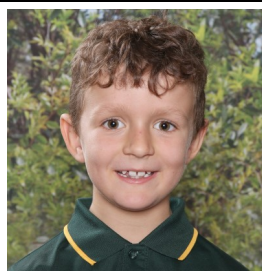

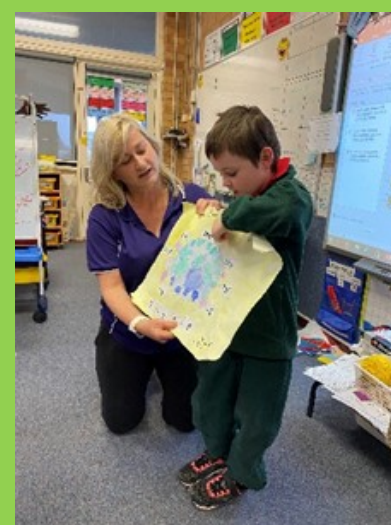

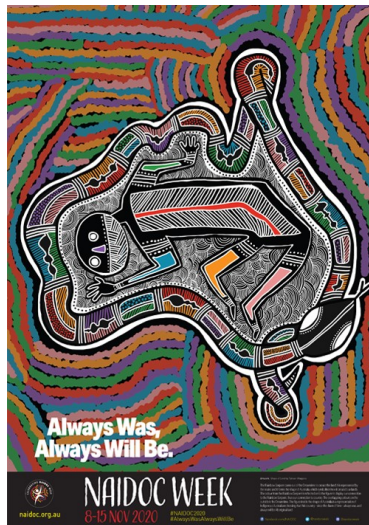
