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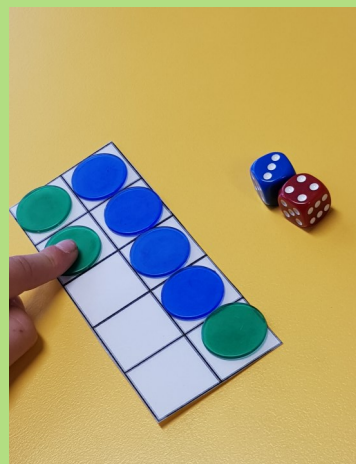

NRMA Science and Road Safety Program

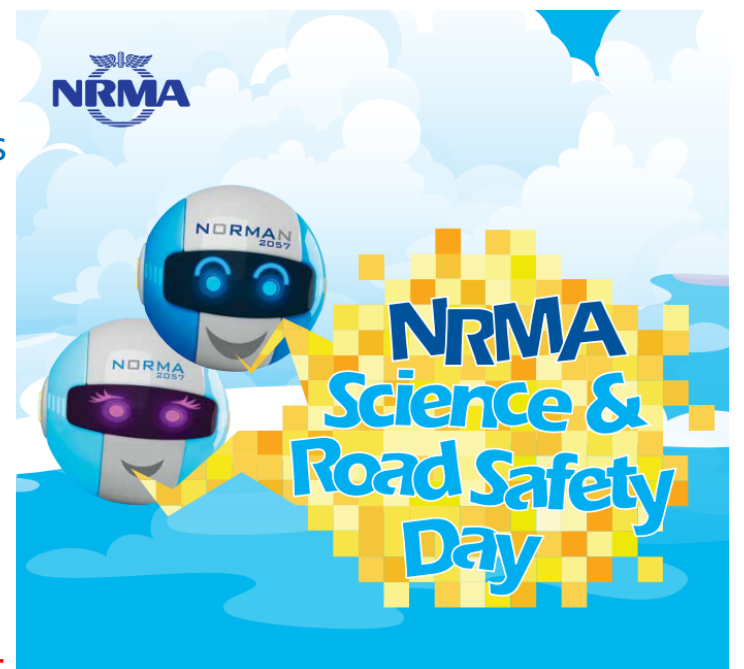
Since 2014 the NRMA Road Safety program has visited 700 schools and educated 300,000 students.

The program teaches children the **WHAT**, **HOW** and **WHY** of road safety.

Children already know that they must "*put on their seatbelt*" or "*wear their helmet*", however this program teaches them **WHAT**

safety equipment is required for each scenario, **HOW** to fit their safety equipment correctly and **WHY** this safety equipment is essential to keep them safe in a crash.

Franklin students are this year, because of Covid-19 restrictions, participating in online learning modules and work sheets during class. This program will run for some weeks during Term 3 at Franklin.
