KINDERGARTEN BEST START INTERVIEWS

Kindergarten 2022 are beginning their Best Start interviews this week.

Best Start has been used in NSW schools since 2010 and identifies students literacy and numeracy skills before entry to Kindergarten. This assessment is mapped to the National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions.

At Franklin our Instructional Leader, Mrs Bye, helps the current Kindergarten teachers to perform the Best Start Assessment.

These assessments will take place Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and will involve no disruption at all to current school programming.

Franklin welcomes our 2022 Kindergarten classes who begin school on 3rd February.

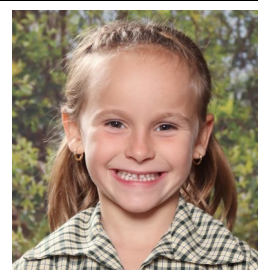

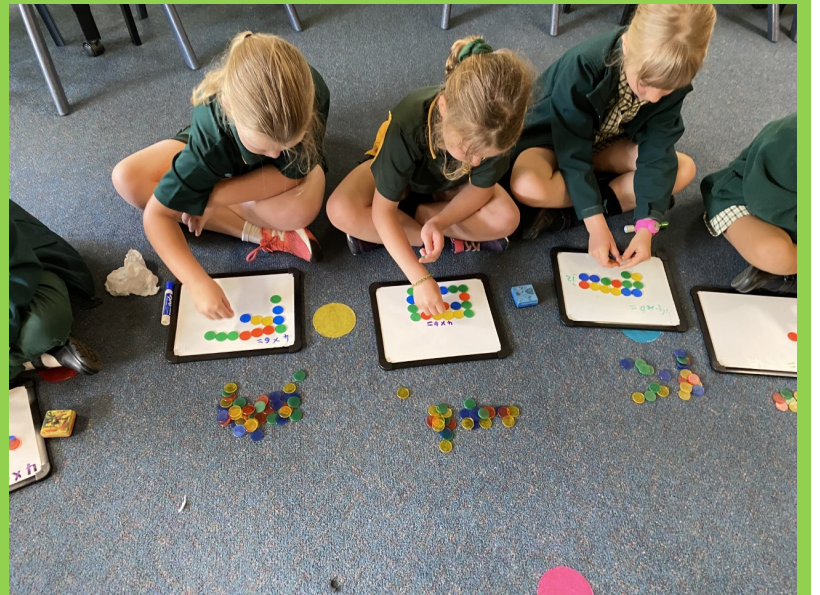

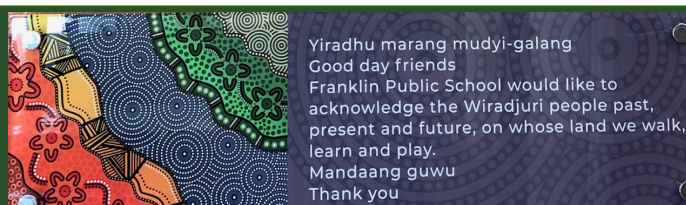
In Mathematics, Bass have been learning about multiplication, area and division. They use hands on activities to consolidate their learning each week which allows students to see real world application of their skills.
