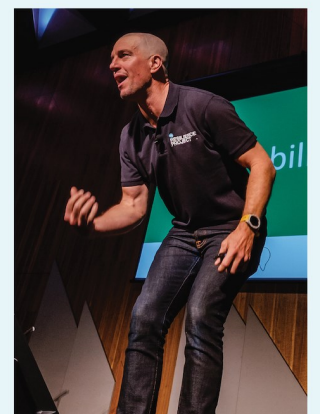
what their children will be learning next year. This will allow parents to use the same positive language and affirmations that staff will be using during the lessons.



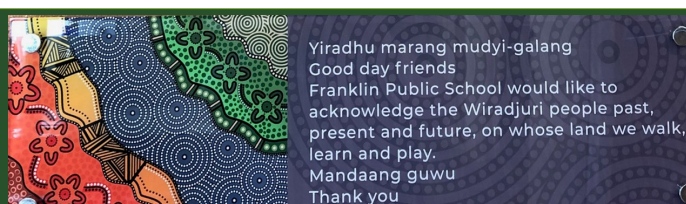
About The Program & Presentation

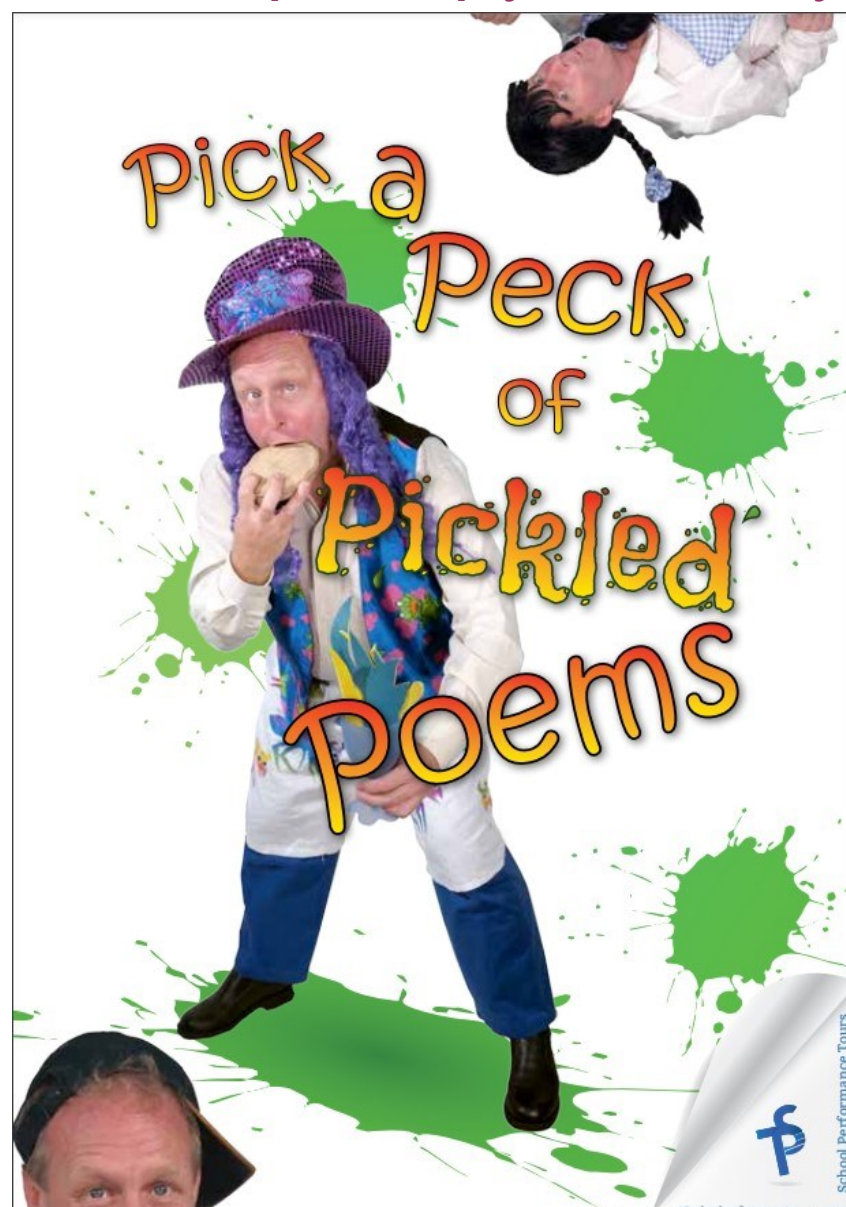
