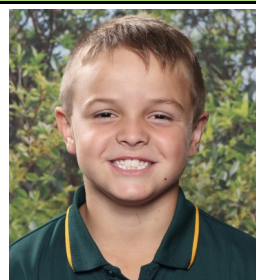

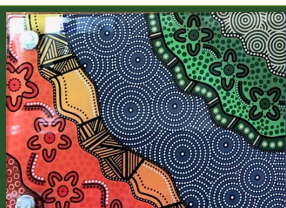
Year 6 Transition at Tumut High School
